SUBJECT: Asbestos Update

In 1986, the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) was signed into law requiring all non-profit Public and Private Schools (K-12) to inspect for the presence of Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM). Academy District 20 has completed the initial inspection on all buildings in the district and continues to monitor the status of any materials found during the inspections. A copy of the inspection and Management Plan which was devised to keep in compliance with applicable regulations can be viewed at the main office of your building or at the Facilities Management Office located at 10221 Lexington Drive, Colorado Springs CO 80920.

The building was purchased in 2012 and an asbestos inspection was performed on August 4, 2014. This initial sampling was conducted to determine whether ACM was present and to assess the physical characteristics of the ACM through the leased portion. No asbestos containing materials were identified in your building during this inspection.
