Home School Section for 2018 -19

Parent/Guardian steps:

1. **Obtain a copy of the Parent/Guardian application** from your home school counselor, from the Aspen Valley Middle School web site, or directly from Aspen Valley Middle School
2. **Complete the form and turn it in to** your home school counselor or directly to AVMS.

Home School Process:

1. Counselor or Parent initiates application process.
2. Home School completes application and compiles required documents.
3. Applications and all paperwork are sent to Aspen Valley Middle School by requested due date, which is April 27, 2018.

1. Aspen Valley Middle School will conduct student and parent interviews once applications are received.
2. Aspen Valley Middle School will send each middle school a list of students who were and who were not accepted.
